Methodology

- Rwandan partners will be invited to visit European partners as the first meeting point for exchanging experiences and good practices on inclusion, accessibility, and disability.
- EU partners will assist partners to adapt and contextualize best practices identified to their own environment. The visits to EU partners will be conducted jointly during the same week (M3) for cost effectiveness purposes. Partners will visit first UA for the Study Visit that will be combined with a Coordination Meeting and then will go to UOM for the Study Visit. Each visit will last 2 working days.
- This WP will be led by UOM and co-led by UA, as both EU partners have an accessibility centre to support students with disabilities and learning difficulties and have the capacity to transfer the know-how gained and experiences that have helped them to reach a successful record of 90% retention rate of students with disabilities within their institutions.

- Exposure of Rwandan partners to innovative practices in the field of inclusion, accessibility and disability via the implementation of relevant study visit agendas.
- Study visits will improve understanding on how EU partners provide support
